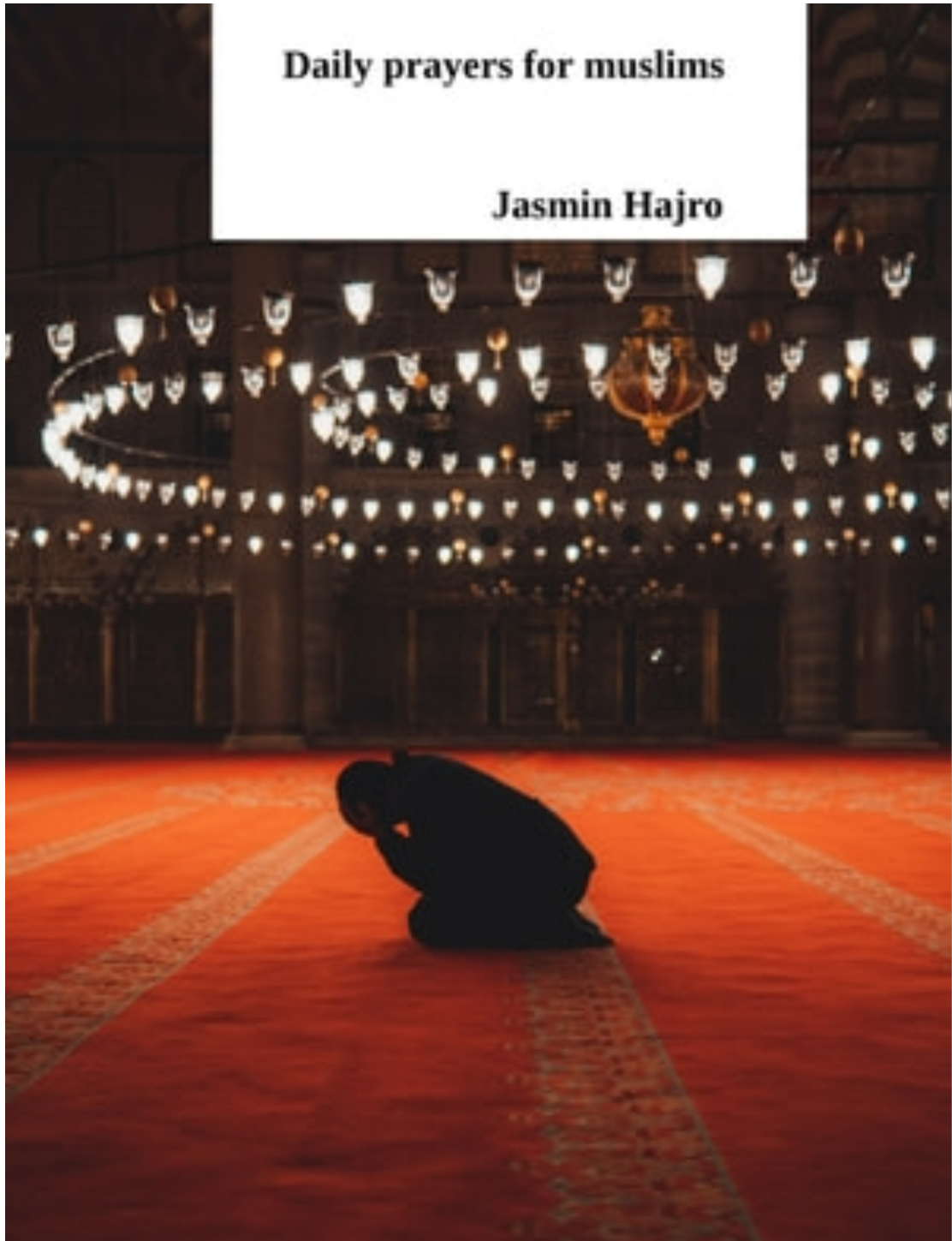


Daily prayers for muslims

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Hello

my name is Jasmin Hajro

I am a war refugee from Bosnia and Hercegovina.

I live in the Netherlands for the past 28 years.

I have a mental disability, for which I have medicine and because of it, I have a income from the Dutch government.

But I do work about 2 hours a day, I sell packages of greeting cards, door to door.

I have designed the greeting cards myself on the laptop.

I also write books, and have written more than 50 booklets by now that you can buy online on many online bookstores and webshops.

I do this on behalf of my little company Hajro International B.V.

So I can live a little better, because the government income is only enough to pay the living expenses, and just survive...Only that.

But I am thankful , because if I still lived in Bosnia

I would not get an income or the needed help,

I may just have gotten medicine....

I have listened to the audiobook on Youtube : Science of getting rich and the author talks about a force that is in everything and is conscious, intelligent, creative and creates, which is obviously God or Allah.

He has devoted a whole chapter on Gratitude...

I have listened several times to the audio booklet...

And since about 2 years ago I started practicing some of the stuff out of that booklet....

So I started saying Everyday : Hvala ti Boze za dans, dobar je dan...

Which is Bosnian for : Thank you God / Allah for today, it is a good day.

I also started saying that same thanksgiving prayer, after every time I sold a package of greeting cards or a book, and also every time, I received or earned money.

You probably understand that a book can only help you, if you take action on what you learn from it, and start doing it...

The way I started doing the Thanksgiving prayer was a bit weird and out of complete desperation....

I listened to successful people on youtube and started doing what they did, like working 7 days a week, to earn more and be more successful

After doing that for 21 days in a row....

I got severe back pains

Because of a overloaded back muscle....

It hurted and would wake up at night and hurt even more....

It hurted every day and every night and woke me up several times at night

I could not sleep right and wasn't worth much during the day

because of the back pain and lack of sleep....

There where few remedies....

I took many Paracetamol which is the same as Aspirine, like 10 or 12 a day

which far too much
I also took Iboprufen, which is about the same painkiller as Aspirine
only a bit stronger...
I would take a hot shower before going to bed ,to relax the muscle...
I would put on a bandaid that gets hot, on the sore muscle, so that it would
relax the muscle
I would go into the kitchen and drink tea and smoke tobacco
After doing all that I could do, the back pain would still wake me up
and hurt.....
So at some point I was frustrated that nothing worked and my back still hurt
and I was walking circles in my living room...
And then I started giving thanks to God / Allah
for everything in my life
I would say thank you for aloud
for my health
mind
body
house
income
work
my books and the inspiration that God / Allah gave me to write them
for my cats
for my family
especially for my mother and sister who always helped me
and my father that stayed in Bosnia to fight in the war
and for every other thing I could think of
And after a while , the pain went away
(maybe the medicine started working)
and I could finally fall asleep
I hope to inspire you, But I urge you to say your Thanksgiving prayers
everyday out loud...
It does not matter if they are in Arabic or your own language
Allah will understand
It is just a better way of living.
(In the booklet as you have seen sometimes will be said : God / Allah
I hope that does not bother you
The goal is to make the booklet helpful to a wider audience
It is my purpose and that of God / Allah to UNITE the people of the earth,
not to separate them)
I was circumcised as a child
and I was raised like a Muslim, when I was a kid in Bosnia
I also went to the mosk...
That has not lasted long, because of the war
I have learned a few prayers
from my grandma
they are mostly Arabic, with maybe a few Bosnian words in them...
I will share them with you...

Another part of the prayers will be too in Arabic, and they will come from my mother

who is helping me to write this booklet,

because she too was raised as a Muslim, but for much more time

like 35 years or something, before the war started and we fled the country...

The last few prayers will be "quoted"

from what I have read, in my later years....

I hope the booklet and prayers are recognizable and beneficial to You

Thank you for choosing my book.

Day 1

"Euzubillah iminesejtan irradzim, Bismillah irrahman irrahim"

"I seek refuge in Allah from Satan, the accursed, in the name of Allah, the Most Merciful, the Most Compassionate."

"This prayer is often recited as a means of seeking protection from evil and invoking the name of Allah before embarking on an action. It is an expression of trust in Allah's mercy and compassion."

Day 2

"Rabijesil velatuasir rabitemin Bil hajr od boga hajr Amin"

(a mix of Arabic and Bosnian prayer)

"O Lord, send ease and not hardship. O Lord, keep us firm and grant us protection. And may Allah grant us protection. Amen."

Day 3

"Malik je umedin ihdine siratel muste kime siratel elezine enamte alejhum gajrul magdubi alejhim veledalin amin"

"Master of the Day of Judgment, You alone we worship, and You alone we ask for help. Guide us on the Straight Path, the path of those who have received Your grace; not the path of those who have brought down wrath upon themselves, nor of those who have gone astray."

"This prayer is recited by Muslims as part of their daily prayers and holds significant spiritual meaning. It seeks guidance, mercy, and protection from going astray in life."

(I was taught to say this prayer when somebody died, to pay respect)

Day 4

"Subhaneke alahume velihamdike vetebare kesluke vetalah jedukke, ve la ilahe gajruke"

"Glory be to You, O Allah, and praise be to You. Blessed is Your name and exalted is Your majesty. There is no deity worthy of worship except You."

"This is a supplication of praise and glorification to Allah in the Arabic language. It acknowledges the greatness and uniqueness of Allah and affirms the belief in His oneness."

Day 5

"Kulhuvelah ehad allahu samed lemjelid velemjuled velem je kulehu kujuven ehad"

"Say, He is Allah, the One and Only;

Allah, the Eternal, Absolute;

He begets not, nor is He begotten;

And there is none like unto Him."

Day 6

“Allahumma inni a'udhu bika min sharabi al-khamri wa ma yuskiru minha wa min a'radhiha wa af'aliha.”

“O Allah, I seek refuge in You from the evil effects of alcohol, its intoxication, the harm it causes and the actions associated with it.”

Day 7

“Allahumma ij'al ahlī wa ā'ilatī ṣāliḥīna, wa siddid khaṭāyahum wa thabbit-hum 'alal-haq, wa ij'al-hum muṭīṭīna laka fīl-khayr wal-birr, wa ij'alnī qurrata 'ayn liwālidī wa sundan li-ahlī wa dhakhran lil-mujtama'.”

“O Allah, make my family virtuous people, guide them to the straight path, make them obedient to You in what is good and right, and make me a source of joy to my parents, a support to my family and an asset to society .”

Day 8

“Allahumma irham wa-ghfir li wa-liwālidayya wa-li-jamī'i al-mu'minīna wa al-mu'mināt, wairham al-muslimīna wa al-muslimāt al-aḥyā'i minhum wa al-amwāt.”

“O Allah, have mercy and forgive me, my parents, all believing men and women. Have mercy on living Muslims and Muslim women and also on the deceased.”

Day 9

“Allahumma innaka 'afuwwun tuhibbu al-'afwa fa'fu 'anni.”

“O Allah, You are Forgiving and You love forgiveness, so forgive me.”

Day 10

“Allahumma a'innee 'ala ta'atika wa ziyaadah fi al-'ibadah, waj'alnee mutahammilan lil-'abaa' wal-mas'ooliyat, wathabita 'alas-sabr wal-ihtimaal, wa mani'nee 'an ash-shahawat wal-muharramaat, ya Rabb al-'aalameen.”

“O Allah, help me in obedience to You and increase in worship. Enable me to bear burdens and responsibilities, to be steadfast in patience and tolerance. Protect me from desires and forbidden things, O Lord of the worlds.”

Day 11

“Allahumma barik li fi maali wa zidni minhu, wa barik li fi ma razaqtani wa qini 'adhaban-naar.”

“O Allah, bless my wealth for me and increase it for me. Bless me also in what You have given me and protect me from the punishment of the Fire.”

Day 12

“Allahumma innaka Kareemun Jawwadun, tuhibbu al-jood, fajud 'alayna bi-joodika al-wasi', waj'alna min al-jawwadeen, warzuqna min fadlika bi ghayr hisaab.”

“O Allah, You are generous and generous, You love generosity, so be generous to us with Your abundant generosity. Make us among those who are generous and provide us with Your bounty without limit.”

“This prayer emphasizes Allah's generosity and magnanimity and begs for His bounty and bounty. It is an acknowledgment of the merciful nature of Allah and a supplication to partake of His bounty and bounty without any restrictions.”

Day 13

“Allahumma irham nisaa'ana wa tawallahn bi rahmatika, wa alhimna al-sabr wa al-tafahhum fi ta'amulihinna. Ya Rabb, ij'alna qudwatan hasanatan

lil-rijal fi ma'amalatina ma'a al-nisa', wa ij'alna ya Allah muhafizina 'ala huquqihinna wa karamatihinna. Ya Rabb, ij'alna qadirin 'ala fahmihinna wa ihtiramihinna, wa atina al-quwwa wa al-hikmah li nawajih ayyi tahdiyati qad tazhar fi tariqina. Ya Allah, ij'al hubbina wa taqdeerina lil-nisa' juz'an min imanina, wa ij'alna abna'an wa azwajan wa akhwan wa abaa'an salihin. Ya Rabb, ihfaz al-nisa' fi jami'i anha' al-'alam min al-zulm wa al-idtihad, wa ij'al al-'adl wa al-musawa yasudan fi 'alaqatina."

"O Allah, be merciful to our women and envelop them in Your mercy. Grant us patience and understanding in our dealings with them. O Lord, make us a good example for men in our dealings with women, and make us, O God, guardians of their rights and dignity. O Lord, enable us to understand and respect them, and grant us the strength and wisdom to face any challenges we may encounter. O Allah, make our love and appreciation for women an integral part of our faith, and make us good sons, husbands, brothers and fathers. O Lord, protect women everywhere from injustice and oppression, and let justice and equality reign in our relationships."

"This prayer emphasizes the importance of respect, understanding, justice and equality in dealing with women. It reminds Muslims to treat women with mercy and dignity, protect their rights and support them in all aspects of life."

Day 14

"Allahumma an'am 'alayna bialghina al-halal alladhi yakunu sababan lilkhayr walbarakah fi hayatina. Ya Rabb, ij'al rizq yansab ilayna min masadirik al-wasi'a bi karamik wa rahmatik. Ijalna min al-ladhina yastakhdimuna tharwatahum bi hikmatin wa 'adl, wa yasahamuna fi rafahat al-mujtama' wa da'm al-foqara' wa al-muhtajin. Ya Allah, ij'alna qawamin 'ala al-sidq wa al-amana fi al-'amal wa al-'amal al-maliyya, wa ij'alna na'mal bi jidd wa ijihad li tahqiq al-najah wa al-istiqrar al-mali. Ya Rabb, ij'alna shakirin li ni'mik wa mutawaddi'in fi istikhdam tharwatina, wa ij'alha wasilatan lilkhayr walbarakah fi hadhihi al-dunya wa al-akhirah. Ameen."

"O Allah, grant us the blessing of halal wealth, which is a means of goodness and blessings in our lives. O Lord, let the provision of our needs flow abundantly and graciously from your ample resources. Make us among those who share their wealth with using wisdom and justice, and contributing to the welfare of society and supporting the poor and needy. O Allah, make us steadfast in honesty and integrity in our work and financial affairs, and let us work hard and strive for success and financial stability. O Lord, let us be grateful for your blessings and humble in the use of our riches, making them a means of goodness and blessings in this life and the hereafter. Amen."

"This prayer expresses the desire to be blessed with truly earned wealth that is used for good purposes, the good of others and the support of those who are less fortunate. It also emphasizes the values of gratitude, humility, honesty and integrity in financial matters."

Day 15

"Elhamdulillah"

"It is a common expression in the Arabic language and is often translated as "All praise be to Allah" or "Thanks be to Allah". It is an expression of

gratitude and praise to Allah.”

Day 16

“Bismillah, alhamdulillah.

Allahumma, abda'u hathihi almahamah bismik, ya arham al-rahimin, ya akram al-akramin. Alhamdulillah, rabb al-'alamin.

Allahumma, as'aluka an tubarak li athna' tanzif jismi wa manzili. Luyakun hatha al'amal 'ibadatan turdika.

Allahumma, athhir qalbi wa nuqqi sudri wa ayyiqidh nayati athna' adha'ih.

Sa'idni 'ala tahyir jismi wa bi'ati min al-najasat, al-jasdiyah wa al-ruhiyah.

Allahumma, aj'al bayti makanan lil-salam wa al-rahah wa al-barakah.

Luyakun mumli'an bil-mahabbah wa al-insijam wa al-diyafah.

Allahumma, azal jami' al-ta'thirat al-salbiyah wa al-ta'qat al-salbiyah min manzili. Ihmihi min al-sharri wa ihdihi ila al-khayr.

Allahumma, as'aluka an tubarak juhudi wa tubarak bayti. Aj'al min bayti maljan lil-iman wa al-taqwa.

Allahumma, qabil hatha al-dua' wa ajib dua'ati. Luyakun 'amali fi al-tanzif masdaran lil-thawab fi al-dunya wa al-akhirah.

Allahumma Ameen.

Yumkin ta'dil wa idafat hatha al-dua' hasaban ihtiyajatik wa nawayak al-shakhsyiyah. Al-muhim huwa an tuzhir al-tafani al-sadiq fi al-si'i lil-taharah wa al-barakah athna' al-tanzif.”

“O Allah, I begin this task with the name of You, the Most Gracious, the Most Merciful. All praise be to You, the Lord of the Worlds.

O Allah, I ask You to bless me in cleaning my body and my house. May this act be an act of worship that pleases You.

O Allah, cleanse my heart and purify my intentions as I perform this task. Help me to purify my body and my environment from impurities, physical and spiritual.

O Allah, let my home be a place of peace, tranquility and blessings. May it be filled with love, harmony and hospitality.

O Allah, remove all bad influences and negative energies from my home. Protect it from evil and guide it to good.

O Allah, I beg You to bless my efforts and bless my home. Make my home a sanctuary of faith and piety.

O Allah, accept this prayer and answer my supplications. May my cleaning work be a source of reward in this life and the hereafter.

Allahumma Ameen.”

This prayer can be adapted and supplemented to your personal needs and intentions. The most important thing is to show sincere dedication in seeking cleanliness and blessings while cleaning.”

Day 17

“”Allahumma ij'alni latifan fi ta'amuli ma'a an-nas, wa'alhimni al-qudrah 'ala an akoona sababan fi basmati wa sa'adati al-akhirin. Ij'al qalbi mali'an bi-rahmah wa at-tasamuh, wa'atini as-sabr wa al-hikmah li-at'aamal bilatif ma'a kulli man al-taqayya. Ya Allah, ij'alni namudhajan hasanan lil-rahmah wa al-mahabbah fi hadha al-'alam, wa waffiqni li-an akoona kareeman wa mutafahiman wa muhtaraman tijaha al-jamie. Ameen.”

““O Allah, make me kind in my dealings with people, and inspire me to be a reason for the smiles and happiness of others. Fill my heart with mercy and forgiveness, and give me patience and wisdom to deal kindly with everyone I meet. O Allah, make me a good example of mercy and love in this world, and help me to be generous, understanding and respectful to everyone. Amen.”

Day 18

““Allahumma ij'al qalbi mutma'inan wa ij'al ruhi sakinatan. Allahumma alhimni al-sukoon fi kulli amr, wa thabbitni 'ala ta'atika wa dhikrika, wa ij'al al-sukoon yagmiruni fi kulli haal. Allahumma albis qalbi thawba al-sukooni wal-tama'nina, wa ij'alni mutma'inan bi qudratika wa rahmatika. Ya Allah, anta al-salaam wa minka al-salaam, fa anzil 'alayya sukoonan min 'indika wa amnuni al-raha wa al-sukoon fi hayati. Ameen.”

“This prayer asks Allah to fill our hearts and souls with peace. We ask Him to inspire us to peace in every situation and to make us steadfast in obedience and remembrance of Him. We beg Allah to wrap us in the garb of tranquility and reassurance, and to make us tranquil by His power and mercy. We ask Allah, the Peaceful, to grant us tranquility from Himself and grant us comfort and peace in our lives. Amen.”

Day 19

““Allahumma inni astawdi'u ka amra 'amali, fa'waffiqni fih wa saddid khutwati, waj'alhu mustaqarra rizqi wa masdar fakhri, warzuqni tawfeeqan fi itmam ma'hayami wa anjiz 'amali bi kulli yusrin wa sahlah. Allahumma ij'al 'amali khalisan li wajhika al-kareem, wa la taj'alni muhsudan 'ala ma anjazu, bal ij'alni sababan lil-khayri wal-fa'idah fi mujtami'i. Ya Rabb al-'Alamin, a'ini 'ala al-sabr wal-ijtihad, wa an'im 'alayya bil-'ilm wal-hikmah li atamakkana min al-qiyam bi 'amali bi kafa'ah wa nijah. Ameen.”

“This prayer asks Allah for His blessing and guidance in our work. We ask Him to make us successful in our tasks and to make our work a stable source of income and a source of pride. We ask for His help in completing our tasks and doing our work with ease and efficiency. We ask Allah to make our work pure for His pleasure and not to make us jealous of what we have achieved, but to make us a means of goodness and usefulness in our community. We ask Allah to grant us patience and diligence, and to bless us with knowledge and wisdom, so that we can complete our work with competence and success. Amen.”

Day 20

““Allahumma barik li fi mali wa zidni minhu wa la tahrمني barakata zakati ma a'taytani. Allahumma ij'al mali tayyiban wa mubarakan, wa ij'alhu wasilatan lil-khayri wal-barakah fi hayati wa hayati al-akhirin. Allahumma arzuqni al-kifayah was-sa'ah fi al-mal, wa ij'alni mina al-ladhina yunfiquna fi sabiilika bi ihsanin wa sakha'a. Allahumma a'ini 'ala istikhdam mali bi hikmatin wa 'adl, wa ij'alhu wasilatan li raf'at qadri wa qudrati 'ala musa'adat al-akhirin. Ya Rabb al-'Alamin, a'ini 'ala tahqiq al-istiqrar al-mali wal-tawfir al-hakim, wa ij'alni mamin ya'mal bi jiddin wa ijihad li kasb rizq halal wa mubarak. Ameen.”

“This prayer asks Allah to bless our money and increase it. We ask Him not to deprive us of the blessings of giving charity. We ask Allah to make our money good and blessed and to make it a means of goodness and blessing

in our lives and the lives of others. We beg Him to provide us sufficiently and abundantly. We beg Him to provide us sufficiently and abundantly so that we are able to meet our needs, fulfill our responsibilities, and be generous to others.”

Day 21

“Allahumma ij'al zakata mali sadaqatan jariyyatan, wa tahir biha qalbi mina al-tama'i wal-bukhl. Allahumma qabbil minni zakati, wa barik li fi ma a'taytani. Allahumma ij'al zakata mali wasilatan lil-taqarrub ilayk wa lil-sa'adah fi al-dunya wal-akhirah. Wa ij'alni mina al-ladhina yunfiquna fi sabiilika bi ihsanin wa iithar. Allahumma ij'al mali nuqtah barakah tanmu fi hayati wa tantashir fi kulli janib min hayati. Allahumma ij'alni mamin ya'tiqu raqabah bi sadaqatihi wa yus'aidu al-fuqara' bi malihi. Ya Rabb al-'Alamin, qabbi minni zakati wa a'ini 'ala tahqiq haqooq al-fuqara' wal-masakeen. Ameen.”

“This prayer asks Allah to accept the Zakat of our money as an ongoing charity and to purify our hearts from greed and avarice. We ask Allah to accept our Zakat and to bless us in what He has given us. We beg Him to make our Zakat a means of drawing closer to Him and bringing happiness in this life and the Hereafter.”

Day 22

“Bismillah, Allahumma inni as'aluka an taj'alani mina al-mustaghfirina al-mutawakkilina alaik, alladhina yathbutuna qulubuhum bi dhikrika wa yaseeruna ala amrihim. Allahumma inna ni'audhu bika mina al-hammi wa al-hazani wa al-karb wa al-khawfi wa al-ghammi wa al-ajzi wa al-kasali wa al-jubni wa al-bukhli wa min ghalabat al-rijal. Ya Allah, ya Rahman, ya Rahim, ya Ghaffar, ya Wadud, ya Karim, ya Latif, ya Halim, ya Subhan, ya Quddus, ya Aziz, ya Jabbar, ya Wahhab, ya Rabb, ya Malik, ya Mun'im, ya Wali, ya Hafiz.

“This prayer seeks Allah's help and protection in overcoming worries and anxieties. It asks Allah to grant strength, trust, and reliance on Him. It seeks refuge from various negative emotions such as grief, sadness, fear, and despair. The prayer also calls upon different names of Allah, invoking His attributes of mercy, love, generosity, and protection.”

Day 23

“Allahumma ya Kareem, ya Waasi' al-'Ataa', ya man laa ya'ud wa laa yuhsaa jooduhu wa karamuhu, naltaajou ilayka wa narfa'u aydeena bid-du'a, ya Rabbal 'aalameen, anta alladhee tumla al-akwaan birahmatika wa karamik, anta alladhee taghmurna bini'mika al-'adheemah. Na'lam ya Allah annaka alkareem al-haleem, alladhee tutee bila hudood wa taghfir bila hisaab, fa nahnu naltaajou ilayka biquloob khaashi'ah wa natlubu minka an tazeedna min fadlika wa karamik. Ya Rabb, ija'alna mustahiqeen li-rahmatika wa 'atfik, wa amhanna min waasi' karamik ma yahqiq lana as-sa'adah wal-rahah fi ad-dunya wal-aakhirah. Anta al-qaadir 'ala kulli shay', wa laa yujad mu'ati akram minka. Narjouka ya Allah an tafatah abwaaba fadlika lana, wa tarzuqna min haythu laa nahsab. Ija'alna muminina yastu'miluna ni'mika bil-shukri wal-ihsaan, wa liyakuna 'ata'uka sababan li-nashri al-khayr wal-sa'adah fi hayatina wa hayatil-akhirin.

Ya Raheem, ya Ghafour, ya Kareem, nahnu bihaaja ila rahmatika wa karamik fi kulli lahza. Ija'alna min alladhina yastahiqqouna rahmatika, wa an'im 'alayna bil-'aafiya wa ar-rizq wa as-sa'adah.

Allahumma inna na'lam anna ay shay'in nahsiluhu fi hadhihil hayaat huwa min fadlika wa ihsaanika. Fa nahnu narfa'u aydeena wa naqoul al-hamdulillah 'ala ni'mika al-waafirah.

Allahumma ya Kareem, ya Waasi' al-'Ataa', nas'aluka an taj'al..."

“The prayer asks Allah, the Gracious and the Merciful, for His bounty and abundant blessings. It recognizes that Allah is the Generous who gives and forgives without limits. It begs Allah to enrich us with His mercy and generosity, both in this life and the hereafter. It emphasizes our dependence on His mercy and calls for health, provision and happiness. It recognizes that everything we receive comes from Allah's favor and goodness, and it ends with a supplication for Allah's generosity and blessings.”

Day 24

“

"Allahumma inni a'oodh bika min 'adhabika, wa a'oodh bika min ghadhabika, wa a'oodh bika minka, laa ahsii thanaa'an 'alayka, anta kama athnayta 'ala nafsik.

Allahumma inni astaghfiruka wa atoobu ilayka min jamee' al-dhunoob wal-khataaya allati iqtarafthuha, wa ana a'lamu bi-anna dha'eefun wa khati', wa lakinnaaka al-ghafoor al-raheem. Farhamni wa ighfir li wa tub 'alayya.

Allahumma inni a'tirfu bi dhanubi wa as'aluka al-'afwa wal-maghfirah. Anta alladhee taghfir al-dhunoob wa taqbal al-tawbah, fa ana arju minka al-rahmah wal-maghfirah, wa an tamhu dhanubi kama yamhu al-thawb al-abyad min al-danas.

Ya Rabbī, ana 'aajiz 'an tasahhiih aakhta'i wa tukaffir dhunoobi bi-mufaridi. Fa anta al-qaadir 'ala thalik. Anta alladhee taqbal al-tawbah wa taghfir al-dhunoob wa tu'eed al-quloub ila ta'atik.

Allahumma inni a'lamu anni asaatu ilayka wa akhta'tu fi haqqi nafsi wa haqqika. Fa ana atoobu ilayka wa astaghfiruka. Anta al-Rahman al-Raheem, farhamni wa tawallani wa ahidni ila ma yardaak.

Allahumma inni a'tirfu bi kulli dhanbin irtakabtuh, kabeeran wa sagheeran, sirran wa 'alaaniyah. Fa ana astaghfiruka wa atoobu ilayka. Alhimni al-quwwah wal-iradah li atark al-khataaya wa a'ood ilayka bi qalbin naqi wa taahir.

Allahumma irhamni wa ighfir li wa tub 'alayya, waj'alni min alladhina yatou..."

It acknowledges the sins committed, both openly and secretly, and seeks forgiveness and repentance from Allah. It requires strength and determination to leave sins behind and return to Allah with a pure and clean heart. It begs for mercy, forgiveness and repentance, and that one be among those who turn to Allah.”

Day 25

“Allahumma ya man anzalta ar-rizq wa qasamtahu, wa hawwanta 'alayna talabahu, wa farajta hamumina bil-ghina. As'aluka ya Allah an-najah wa at-tawfiq fi umuri 'amali wa tijarati. Make my work blessed and successful, and help me to achieve my goals and achieve success in all that I undertake. O Lord of the worlds, grant me knowledge and wisdom to make the right and make appropriate decisions, and grant me patience and steadfastness in the face of challenges and difficulties. You are the Hearer of prayer.”

Day 26

It begs for understanding and clarity to deal with all matters with wisdom and justice. It desires the ability to distinguish truth from falsehood and to avoid malice and sin. It begs for wisdom in dealing with people, understanding and patience in difficult situations. It requires enlightenment of the heart with knowledge and wisdom so that one is able to make right and useful decisions. It asks Allah to grant strength to act with wisdom and take steps on the path of goodness and success. It recognizes that Allah is All-Knowing and All-Wise, and that He has power over everything.”

Day 27

It is a reminder that Allah has given strength to His prophets and loved ones in difficult times and asks for a share of that strength. It calls for strength in the face of challenges and steadfastness in the face of adversity, and begs Allah not to be defeated or lose hope. It recognizes that Allah is the Almighty who is capable of everything, and asks for help and strength to rise from darkness to light and from weakness to strength.”

Day 28
